## MANAGEMENT OF THE FIRST 10 EU GPP CRITERIA

SEMCo has analysed the differences between the Swedish GPP criteria and the EU GPP criteria for the first 10 product groups. In the table below you'll find information if there are Swedish GPP criteria in place for the specific product group and comments on how these criteria will be handled in SEMCo's criteria process.

Product area	Swedish GPP criteria available	Time plan for development/up-dating	Comments
1. Copying and graphic paper	Yes	Update planned for in autumn -09	Correlates partly, there are differences in scope and alignment. SEMCo's criteria comprise also tissue paper and other paper products. SEMCo's criteria doesn't comprise content of recycled paper or paper based on legally and/or sustainably harvested virgin fibre.
2. IT-products	Yes	Recently updated – update with the new Energy Star criteria in July-09. No adjustment towards the EU GPP criteria is planned	Correlates partly, SEMCo's criteria more driving and more precisely formulated.
3. Cleaning products and services	Yes	Cleaning services recently developed. Cleaning products planned to be updated in spring 2010.	Products - EU criteria have a smaller scope (only for household). Services – SEMCo's criteria are more precisely formulated.
4. Construction	Yes	Recently developed. No adjustment towards the EU GPP criteria is planned.	SEMCo criteria comprise more aspects and are more precisely formulated.

Product area	Swedish GPP criteria available	Time plan for development/up-dating	Comments
5. Transport	Yes	Recently updated. Some aspects in the EU criteria will be looked into when updating the criteria.	EU criteria don't comprise traffic safety. EU core criteria for busses and waste collection trucks are very tough concerning emissions - EURO V. EU criteria comprises aspects that SEMCo's criteria doesn't, among other things air-conditioning systems with low GWP (global warming potential) coolers. SEMCo will look into this during the update. SEMCo don't have specific criteria for waste collection trucks. SEMCo's criteria for freight transports are more developed.
6. Furniture	Yes	Update planned for in autumn -09	EU criteria are more generic written. Some aspects are missing in the EU criteria, for example flame retardants. EU criteria are not formulated in a precise manner. SEMCo doesn't have criteria for sustainable forestry. SEMCo has a working group that will develop generic forestry criteria for wood based products.
7. Textiles	Yes	Update planned for in autumn -09	EU criteria are well formulated and will be used as a basis when updating SEMCo's criteria.

Product area	Swedish GPP criteria available	Time plan for development/up-dating	Comments
8. Electricity	Yes	Update planned for in 2010	Big differences between the two sets of criteria probably because of different market supply of electricity. EU criteria don't comprise how the renewable energy sources are used. SEMCo's criteria cover the EU criteria except the award of high efficiency cogeneration. This will be looked into during the updating. SEMCo's criteria are also divided in two parts – one part for purchase of electricity and one part for purchase of mediating of electricity.
9. Food and catering services	Yes	Updating under progress – ready autumn/winter -09.	SEMCo criteria are better defined and more detailed. The verification help in SEMCo's criteria are much more detailed. EU criteria comprise sustainable production with a very small market share, for example aquaculture and marine products.
10. Gardening products and services	No	Will be handled during the autumn -09.	SEMCo will analyse the need for these criteria and if the criteria are suitable in Sweden.

3. Combined Heat and Power	No	Autumn -09	SEMCo will look into this in order to analyse the need for criteria for this product category.
4. Hard Floor Coverings	No	Development of criteria for re-building planned for autumn -09	Are partly comprised in SEMCo's criteria for construction.
5. Mobile Phones	Yes	Under development – ready in autumn -09.	SEMCo's criteria has a wider scope (comprise also other telecom products) SEMCo's criteria will be sent to the Commission as an input
6. Road Surfacing Materials and Traffic Signs	No	Autumn -09	SEMCo will look into this in order to analyse the need for criteria for this product category.
